### October 2024

- Please cover the Scholars Team in prayer as they meet at the High Leigh conference centre, Hertfordshire, UK. Pray for a meaningful time together as a team and safe travels for everyone. Scholars' team members will also be taking the opportunity to visit scholars on their way to or from the team meeting; please pray for these visits, too.
- Please pray for Lina Toth as the Programme Director and also for safe travels as she will be in Ghana for the Leadership Team meetings just before the Scholars Team meets in Hertfordshire.
- Please pray for Scholar Care Coordinator Mardochee as he will travel to Ghana to meet with a current scholar and be on campus at Akrofi Christaller. This is a key regional school and the Scholars' team is keen to continue building a relationship with them.
- Please pray for the entire Scholars' team as they finalise the strategic plan for the Scholars Programme and work on the budget requests for the next financial year.
- Langham Preaching seminars will take place this month in Eswatini, Philippines, Romania, Sri Lanka, Slovenia, Thailand, Trinidad & Tobago, Uruguay and five other sensitive countries. Pray for the facilitators who will lead the training and that the participants will be encouraged by all they have learned.
- Pray for our Continental Directors who oversee the staff teams in Latin America, Europe, the Caribbean, Africa, Asia and the South Pacific. Pray for wisdom and strength as they lead disparate teams around the world from diverse backgrounds and cultures.
- The catalogues for the 2024 / 2025 Library Grant Programme are currently in production (one in English and one in French). Pray that all the various elements will come together in a timely way and that there will be no unnecessary delays.
- On 27 October a new indigenous publishing house will be launched in Ethiopia, *Onesimus Theological Publishing*, envisioned for many years by Dr Tekalign Duguma but finally coming to life with assistance from Langham. Early priorities include an exegetical Bible commentary series by Ethiopian writers, designed for Ethiopian pastors, 90% of whom have no formal training. Pray for energy and perseverance for Tekalign and for major impacts on preaching and teaching in the vernacular languages.
- Please pray for members of the Publishing Management Group Hani, Liz, and Rico who participated in the Lausanne congress and for the work that will grow out of the meetings there. Pray for wisdom and strength. Specifically, please pray for Rico and Joy Faraz as they met with a team working on the history/biography of Asian Christian Leaders towards developing the one-volume book.

#### November 2024

- Preaching Movement Coordinators from the Caribbean region will gather together in Jamaica for four days this month. They will meet to discuss and make plans for the region; for training and fellowship. Desmond Rogers, our Regional Coordinator for the region, will

be leading this time together. Please pray that Langham Preaching will be strengthened and further established in the countries of the Caribbean.

- The Europe and Caribbean team members will meet in Dublin, Ireland this month. It will be an important time for them to look ahead to the coming months and to reflect. Pray for a beneficial time for the work of Langham Preaching as well as in fellowship and spiritual growth.
- Please pray for the Literature team as they meet as a team in San Diego, spend time in fellowship and business meetings, and attend the Evangelical Theological Society Annual meeting 20<sup>th</sup>- 22<sup>nd</sup> November and the Society of Biblical Literature Annual meeting 23<sup>rd</sup>-26<sup>th</sup> November.
- Pray for the LittWorld conference of writers, publishers and media people, held in Mexico, and expecting to host more than 250 delegates from around the globe.
