### April 2026

- Please pray for wisdom for Riad Kassis as he leads Langham Partnership. Please pray for his protection and that God would give him wisdom.
- A Facilitators Workshop for the region of Southern Africa will take place this month. Please pray for those who will receive training in learner-centred facilitator practice. Pray that they will be able to pass on their skills to others.
- A week of focusing on training young leaders in the South Pacific will take place in Fiji. Participants will come from Fiji, Vanuatu, the Solomon Islands, Papua New Guinea, Tonga, and New Caledonia. Pray that these younger men and women will increase in their desire to preach God's Word faithfully, clearly and relevantly.
- Pray for the Society for the Study of Theology Annual Conference in the UK and for Hannah Wright and Esther Newton attending the conference, sharing about our recent publications in theology and running a bookstall.
- Please pray for the French Editorial Coordinator Claire Moore as she attends Le Centre Evangélique 2026 in Paris and shares our latest releases with the Francophone community, networks and meets authors.
- Pray for the Vision Weekend taking place in the US this month and for the literature staff sharing about the publishing work.
- Pray for newly established indigenous publishing house 'Onesimus' as the leaders forge ahead with writing and publishing a series of exegetical commentaries for Ethiopian preachers. There are at least 30 million Christians in Ethiopia and Onesimus is the only indigenous publisher seeking to meet its resource needs. They plan to publish 10 new titles in 2026.
- Please pray for the scholars and their families whose countries are suffering, through war, political conflict, persecution, and poverty in different parts of the world. Pray for their safety and their communities.
- Please pray for the last preparations for the Scholar Gatherings to be held around the world in 2026. These events enable Scholars to come together for mutual encouragement and support, giving them an opportunity to present from their research as well as to enjoy times of fellowship together. The North America Scholar Gathering will be held at Asbury Theological Seminary from 16 to 19 April 2026.
- Please pray for our scholars who have submitted their theses and are awaiting examinations and defences to be arranged in the very near future.
- Please pray for the final Selection Committee meeting this month.

### May 2026

- Please pray for the three days of Leadership Team meetings which will be held via Zoom and for the four days of International Council meetings which follow after that. Please pray for wisdom, discernment and productive meetings.
- Pray for our Preaching Movement Coordinators around the world who look after our 121 preaching movements in over 100 countries. They are working alongside their national committees to lead the work in seven key areas - leadership, finance, preaching clubs, facilitators, diversity, impact and resources.
- Level 1 and 2 seminars will take place this month in Madagascar. Pray for the facilitators and participants as they learn and practice together.
- Please pray for the Mediafest in Prague, 5-8 May. Local heart-language European publishers, writers, editors and media people will gather in Prague at the Media Associates International (MAI) training and sharing event. Pray for much encouragement, fellowship, learning and vision, and for literature team members attending.
- Please pray for Roman Soloviy's work on the final Ukrainian manuscript of the book *Theology and Practice of Hospitality in Times of War and Conflict* and for the editors and contributors of the book project *Pastoral Ministry During Wartime: The Ukrainian Experience*.
- Please pray for Rico Villanueva as he is speaking at the OMF Field conference in Cambodia and meeting with the local publishing team.
- Dr. Parush Parushev will be visiting the Ukrainian Evangelical Theological Seminary to hold research seminars and workshops on doctoral supervision for the faculty of the newly licensed doctoral programme of the school. Pray for fruitful meetings and further relationship building.

- Please pray for the final preparations for the Francophone Africa Scholar Gathering taking place 17–21 May at Université de l'Alliance Chrétienne d'Abidjan (UACA), Côte d'Ivoire, and also for the Latin-American Scholar Gathering, which will happen on 1–3 June in São Paulo, Brazil.

## June 2026

- June is the end of Langham Partnership's financial year. Please pray that God would bless abundantly with income so that we are able to continue with the exciting and life-changing work that has been opened up for us to do around the world, partnering with our Majority World brothers and sisters.
- As our teams seek to increase the number of Small Preaching Groups in the various movements around the world, pray for those who are leading and coordinating the groups. Pray that they will be encouraged in all that is being learned and the relationships that are being developed.
- Please pray for the new movements that are in the planning stages for commencing in the months ahead. A lot of ground work takes place before preaching training begins. Pray for the Regional Coordinators as they support Preaching Movement Coordinators and National Committees.
- The 2025 / 2026 Library Grant season will conclude this month. Give thanks for the many books that have been sent to colleges throughout the majority world. Pray that they will be a source of inspiration and a deepening knowledge for all who use them.
- Please pray for the publishing team attending Yale-Edinburgh Conference on World Christianity and the History of Mission at New College, University of Edinburgh.
- Please pray for the various academic works and events that our regional coordinators are involved in across the world. This month keep in your prayers Roman Soloviy's involvement in 2026 EEIT Summer School on Theo-political Imagination and the Webinar on Foundations of Academic Literacy with Dr Kevin Gary.
- Please pray for the writers and editors of the ongoing Hippo Exegetical Bible Commentary Series. This series featuring African biblical scholars is a multi-year project that brings solid Bible exegesis combined with contextual commentary.
- Please pray for applicants who will receive a Langham Scholarship, starting in July 2026 and also for the many applicants who will be disappointed not to be amongst this group this year. Especially pray for new Langham Scholars who will be starting their PhD study programme in the next few months.
- Please pray for the Latin-American Scholar Gathering that will take place from 1–3 June in São Paulo, Brazil. Pray for the health and safety of the scholars attending, and especially for a productive time of fellowship and connection among them.
- Several scholars and graduates are planning study residencies in the coming months in Singapore, the UK, and other countries, pending visa approval. Please pray that their visa applications are successful and that each scholar experiences a fruitful and productive time during their residency.

## July 2026

- Please pray for new National Members who are joining Langham Partnership as fundraising entities. Please pray that all of the legal issues will go smoothly to register them as charities in their various countries and that these would provide another channel for God's people to give to the work.
- Two resources are in the process of being produced looking at our learning outcomes of 'Confident in Conviction' and 'Christlike in Character'. Articles have been submitted from contributors all around the world. Pray for those that are helping with production and those that are in the process of writing.
- Pray for our Continental Directors who oversee the staff teams in Latin America, Europe, the Caribbean, Africa, Asia and the South Pacific. Pray for wisdom and strength as they lead disparate teams around the world from diverse backgrounds and cultures.
- Pray for the newly established indigenous publishing house QUITANDA as they move operations from Portuguese-speaking Brazil to Portuguese-speaking Angola. Quitanda is focused on nurturing African authors to meet African needs.
- Please pray for the Tyndale Fellowship Conference attended by Evangelical Biblical and Theological scholars from the UK and elsewhere at High Leigh Conference Centre in July 2026 and for Mark Arnold from the Literature team, who will be attending.
- Please pray for the Society of Old Testament Studies meeting in Nottingham and for the Society of New Testament meeting in Durham, where the publishing staff will be representing Langham.
- Please pray for our new Langham Graduates (i.e., those who have received their doctorates in the last 12 months). Especially remember those who will be transitioning back to their home countries in the next few months and maybe picking up new responsibilities with their sending institutions.
- Pray for the supervisors around the world who are working with Langham scholars. The supervisor relationship can be one of the most helpful or most frustrating relationships in the PhD journey, so pray that scholars and their supervisors will find ways to work together well.

## August 2026

- The need for resources in print and non-print formats, and to be available in a wide range of heart languages is great. Pray that we will be able to find translators who can assist us and for creativity in the use of technology for our resources.
- Pray for our administrators around the world who work hard behind the scenes assisting in the smooth operational running of Langham Preaching. They are based in Bolivia, Ghana, UK, Indonesia, India and Egypt.
- Pray for various writing and literature passionate people in the region who are seeking to nurture momentum in local publishing. Parts of the region are not easy contexts for publishing, but the nascent indigenous language churches badly need resources in their own language.
- Please pray for the writing projects that are being commissioned and written. Give thanks for the authors' talents in serving the Kingdom of God and for wisdom, perseverance, peace, clarity, and strength.
- Please keep in prayers our distribution team, for strength and wisdom. Give thanks for their good work and the essential role they play in equipping individuals, colleges, libraries and preachers all across the world.
- Pray for the Scholar Care Coordinators as they regularly meet with Langham Scholars, providing support and encouragement throughout their PhD journey.
- Pray for scholars with school-age children. For those studying outside of their own country or region, the school system may be different to what their children are used to, so pray for good academic settings for these families. The PhD journey includes the entire family, and when families are having a hard time, it impacts a scholar's ability to focus on their PhD work.

- Two new projects are underway in the creation of indigenous resources. Both will originate in Latin America and be written in heart languages first. One is being created by the Quechua people in Bolivia. Pray for the team who are leading this exciting development.
- Many of our preaching movements face challenges whether it be political instability, natural disasters, war, poverty or persecution. Pray for those who are serving in these difficult environments and that our global leadership team will be able to support them in the best ways we can.
- Please pray for the Regional Commissioning Editors and the various projects they are involved in and their academic work in universities and colleges. Pray for Rico Villanueva, Elizabeth Mburu, Yacouba Sanon, Roman Soloviy, and Hani Hanna. Please pray for Nyambura Kamau, the HEBC Administrator and Coordinator for Partner Relations in Africa, and her work in connecting with people in the region.
