Do please join us in giving thanks to God for our financial year ended 30th June 2025 which marked the end of our four-year 'Magnify' appeal. The successful conclusion of that campaign made available significant resources to expand our three global programmes, and the headline figures provided by our external Impact Report testify that Langham served 1,958,192 people globally, directly or indirectly! This is an extraordinary number and our thanks are due to all who shared with us the privilege of being engaged in Langham's mission and ministry in order to deliver at such a level. Thanks be to God with a loud 'Hallelujah'!

A special highlight in the middle of this financial year, November 2024, was a Langham trip to Egypt and down the Nile. This event introduced our work in the MENA region where we are helping develop the first local area theological PhD programme. This is a joint initiative between the seminaries in Beirut, Bethlehem and Cairo and the trip helped fundraise to sponsor the academic faculty and deliver the necessary foundational resources.

One key episode on our Egypt visit was an afternoon hosted at the Evangelical Theological Seminary of Cairo. We were addressed by several Langham Scholars: one recently returned to Cairo to head the Old Testament department having achieved her PhD in the USA; one a previous principal of the seminary; another previous principal who is now the director of our Langham



Literature programme; and another now President of the Protestant Churches in Egypt, Head of the Coptic Church aid organisation and advisor to the government on religious affairs! As well as hearing testimony of our Langham Scholars programme (and the key pastoral and discipleship care and support which underpins this success) we were also helped to appreciate the contribution these 'Langham-ites' made through their authorship, editing, preaching seminars and support for preaching clubs. All three programmes were acknowledged and much celebrated.

These details help us appreciate the individual testimonies which lie behind the 1.9m figure mentioned above. It is surely no overstatement to say that the world is a different place as a result of your prayerful support – thank you for help in supplying the necessary resources.

Langham UK and Ireland in Numbers

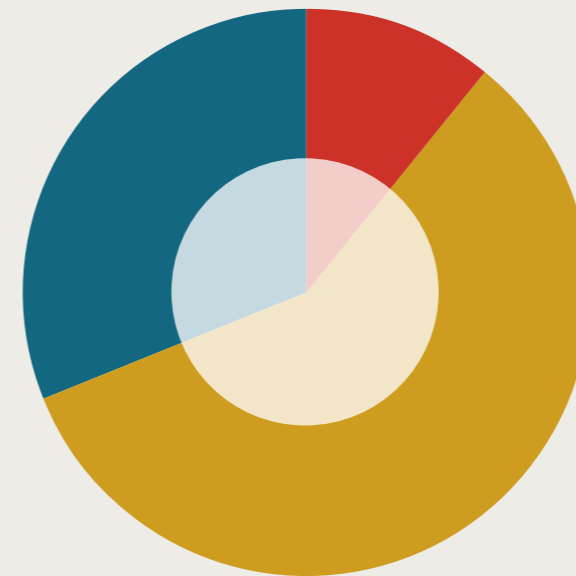
Langham UK and Ireland is extremely grateful for the generosity of its donors which enables its mission and ministry, under God, to advance.

Langham Partnership UKI raises funds from UK supporters which are then used to fund programme activity.

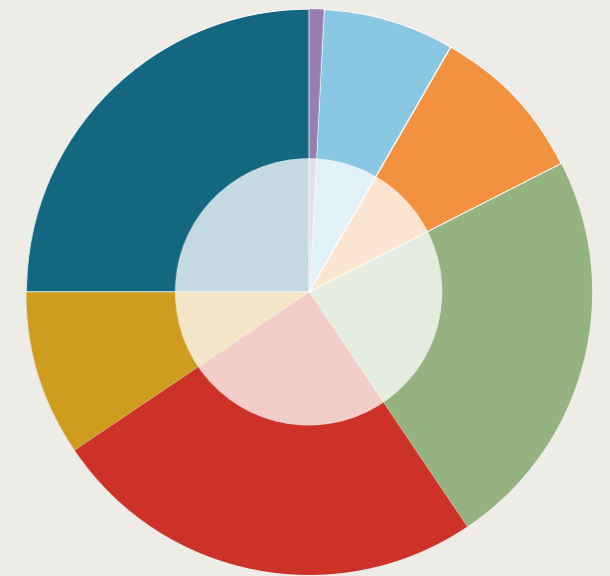
At the same time, it operates as 'banker' for the programmes and receives funds from other Langham Partnership entities across the world (USA, Canada, Hong Kong, Australia and New Zealand) and deploys these to fund programme activities.

In 2024-25, 83% of expenditure relates to the three programme streams of Literature, Preaching and Scholars.
