### 8 - 16 January: Scholars

**8 Jan:** Give thanks for the 14 Langham Scholars who graduated last year and returned to their home countries to serve there.

**9 Jan:** Langham Graduate Elie Haddad is the President of Arab Baptist Theological Seminary in the Lebanon. Pray for him and his staff after an extremely tiring year.

**10 Jan:** Pray for 23 new Langham Scholars, especially as some are facing difficulties with starting their courses due to COVID-19 restrictions.

**11 Jan:** A recent survey showed that many Langham Graduates are teaching seminary courses online at the moment. Pray for enthusiasm and energy.

**12 Jan:** Pray for our Scholar Care Coordinators, including Liz and Malcolm McGregor in Scotland, who provide vital support to Scholars in the UK.

**13 Jan:** Pray that God will give Langham Scholar Rania Hendy, from Egypt, wisdom in selecting a dissertation topic.

**14 Jan:** Langham Scholar Aoum from Thailand is studying at Wycliffe College, Canada. Pray he'll be able to finish his dissertation before the end of 2021, despite libraries being closed at the moment.

**15 Jan:** Give thanks that between July 2019 and June last year, Langham supported 78 PhD students.

**16 Jan:** Pray for Riad Kassis in Lebanon as he directs the Scholars programme.

## **17 - 23 January: Literature**

**17 Jan:** Pray for Libby Kelly, Langham Literature's Director of Operations, as she oversees many aspects of the programme including distribution thousands of books to the Majority World.

**18 Jan:** Dr Solomon Andria, who served as Literature Coordinator for Francophone Africa, retired last week. Pray for his successor Dr Yacouba Sanon.

**19 Jan:** Give thanks that between July 2019 and June last year, 642 Majority World colleges received nearly 14,000 books.

**20 Jan:** Pray for the impact of Langham's new releases, including 'Forgiveness, Peace-making and Reconciliation', a series of contributions from different African voices.

**21 Jan:** Pray for Colin Macpherson, Langham's Director of Publisher Development, as he seeks to nurture and support indigenous evangelical publishers.

**22 Jan:** Pray for Pieter Kwant and Luke Lewis as they direct Langham Literature and Langham Publishing respectively.

**23 Jan:** Give thanks that despite the pandemic, Langham published 44 books.

**30 Jan:** Pray for Johnny McClean, a facilitator with the preaching movement in Thailand and other countries in Southeast Asia

**31 Jan:** Desmond Rogers has taken up a part-time position working for Langham Preaching in Europe and the Caribbean. Pray for him as he adapts to the new role, working from his home in Guyana.
