1 - 5 September: General

1 September: At the start of a new academic year for many, please pray for Langham's endeavours as staff return to their desks and projects begin.

2 September: Give thanks for the new Langham Service Centre in Carlisle from where we distribute books to colleges around the world. Pray there'll be few shipping delays as stock is moved to the new facility.

4 September: Praise God for The Stott Legacy Podcast, which celebrates John Stott's impact in the lives of many people around the world.

5 September: Langham has six fundraising teams: UKI, US, Canada, Australia, New Zealand and Hong-Kong. Pray for wisdom and perseverance in these teams.

6 - 12 September: Scholars

6 September: Give thanks for Scholar Care Coordinators Liz and Malcolm McGregor's presentations at the Bangor Worldwide Missionary Convention last month.

7 September: Langham Scholar Gerardo Corpeño asks us to pray for his home country Guatemala, where the Covid situation is getting worse.

8 September: Pray for Langham Scholar Aoum from Thailand, as he continues writing the fourth chapter of his dissertation.

9 September: Last month, Dr Lina Toth joined Langham to care for Scholars in Eurasia. Pray that she'll settle into the role and get to know the Scholars quickly.

10 September: Pray for Pancha Yahya, from Indonesia, who is studying in the US.

11 September: Praise God for the Everest Theological Institute in Nepal, where Langham Graduate Dr Chubamongba is the Principal. Pray that Dr Chubamongba will stay close to God as he leads the institute.

12 September: Pray for Stefanii Morton, in the US, in her vital role as Executive Assistant for the Langham Scholars programme.

18 September: Praise God for Langham Preaching in the Philippines, which has exploded in growth since it began two years ago.

19 September: Pastors and leaders in Chile and Uruguay are currently being invited to attend Level 1 Langham Preaching training (remotely). Please pray that those who need the training will respond, and attend.

21 September: Pray for the final touches on the Amharic Africa Bible Commentary, as the commentaries and articles are inspected to ensure they're ready for printing.

26 September: Pray for Africa Renewal University in Uganda, which received over 100 books from Langham this year for its recently renovated library.
